# Early Childhood Immunization Form

Must be on file **before** a child attends any early childhood programs\*

Minnesota law requires children enrolled in early education programs to be immunized against certain diseases or file a legal medical or conscientious exemption.

**Parent/Guardian:**

You may attach a copy of the child's immunization history to this form OR enter the MONTH, DAY, and YEAR for all vaccines your child received. Enter MED to indicate vaccines that are medically contraindicated including a history of disease, or laboratory evidence of immunity and CO for vaccines that are contrary to parent or guardian's conscientiously held beliefs.

Sign or obtain appropriate signatures on reverse. Complete section 1A or 1B to certify immunization status and section 2A to document medical exemptions (including a history of varicella disease) and 2B to document a conscientious exemption.

Additionally, if a parent or guardian would like to give permission to the early education program to share their child's immunization record with Minnesota's immunization information system, they may sign section 3 (optional).

For updated copies of your child's immunization history, talk to your doctor or call the Minnesota Immunization Information Connection (MIIC) at 651-201-5503 or 800-657-3970.

\*Early childhood programs are defined as programs that provide instructional or other services to support children's learning and development and:

- Serve children from birth to kindergarten.
- Meet at least once a week for at least six weeks or more during the year.

This includes but not limited to early childhood family education (ECFE), early childhood special education (ECSE), school readiness programs, and other public and private preschool and pre-kindergarten programs.

<b>Haemophilus influenzae type b (Hib)</b> • 2-3 doses in the first year • 1 dose required after 12 months or older • For unvaccinated children 15-59 months, 1 dose is required • Not required for children 5 years or older						
<b>Varicella (chickenpox)</b> • Required for children 15 months and older • 1 <sup>st</sup> dose on or after 1 <sup>st</sup> birthday • 2 <sup>nd</sup> dose at 4-6 years						
<b>Pneumococcal Conjugate Vaccine (PCV)</b> • Required for children age 2 - 24 months • 3 doses in the first year • 4 <sup>th</sup> dose after 12 months • At least 1 dose is recommended for children age 24-59 months in child care						
<b>Hepatitis B (hep B)</b> • 2-3 doses in the first year • 3 <sup>rd</sup> dose (final dose) by 18 months						
<b>Hepatitis A (hep A)</b> • 2 doses separated by 6 months for children 12 months and older

<b>Rotavirus</b> (2-3 doses between 2 and 6 months)

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**2. Exemptions to Immunization Law.** Complete A and/or B to indicate type of exemption.

Medical exemption:</b>                  No child is required to receive an immunization if they have a medical contraindication, history of disease, or laboratory evidence of immunity. For a child to receive a medical exemption, a physician, nurse practitioner, or physician assistant must sign this statement:                   I certify the immunization(s) listed below are contraindicated for medical reasons, laboratory evidence of immunity, or that adequate immunity exists due to a history of disease that was laboratory confirmed (for varicella disease see * below). Conscientious exemption:</b>                  No child is required to have an immunization that is contrary to the conscientiously held beliefs of his/her parent or guardian. However, not following vaccine recommendations may endanger the health or life of the child or others they come in contact with. In a disease outbreak, children who are not vaccinated may be excluded in order to protect them and others. 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**3. Parental/Guardian Consent to Share Immunization Information (optional):**

Your child's early childhood program is asking your permission to share your child's immunization documentation with MIIC, Minnesota's immunization information system, to help better protect children from disease and allow easier access for you to retrieve your child's immunization record. You are not required to sign this consent; it is voluntary. In addition, all the information you provide is legally classified as private data and can only be released to those legally authorized to receive it under Minnesota law.
