INFORMATION & EARLY RELEASE

11th Grade ACT Plus Writing Exam – All 11th Grade Students

All ISD 196 juniors will take the ACT Plus Writing test on Tuesday, April 19, from 7:30am-1:00pm. Scores are college reportable and the test is offered at no cost to the student. There is no pre-registration required. Results will be accepted by all four-year colleges and universities in the United States and students will have the option of using their test score from this official test date for their post high school planning.

The ACT includes 215 multiple-choice questions and takes a little longer than 4 hours to complete, including a short break. The test includes 4 subject area tests and a 40 minute writing essay prompt. The number of questions and the time allowed follows:
English: 75 questions - 45 min | Math: 60 questions - 60 min. | Reading: 40 questions - 35 min. | Science: 40 questions - 35 min.

Breakfast: Students are strongly encouraged to eat a good breakfast with protein-rich foods that can lead to greater mental alertness. Whole grain bagels will be provided at no cost for all students. Also breakfast options in our food service area beginning at 7am in the commons may be purchased (or use PIN ID). These options include: breakfast pizza, mini donuts, assorted muffins, assorted cereal, pop tarts, granola bars, fruit, juice and milk.

Snack Break: A snack break is scheduled at approximately 9:45am. A snack bar and bottled water will be provided.

Cell Phone/Backpacks: Students are not allowed to bring backpacks or cell phones to the test site location. ACT policy requires student dismissal from the test if phones are accessed at any time during the test session – including break time.

Students will be released from school at the conclusion of the exam (approximately 1:00pm). Those choosing early release will need to leave the building and may not return until 2:25pm if they are involved in a supervised activity. Only Bag Lunch Service will be available for students wishing to take a school lunch. Bus transportation will be provided on the normal schedule. Students leaving immediately after the exam will provide their own transportation.

In School Supervision OPTION: Parent will complete the below form

1. Students choosing to stay in school through the end of the school day will eat lunch at 1:00pm and be involved in a one period study hall in the West Commons until 2:25pm.
2. Food Services Bag Lunch option/s. (Bag lunch includes: sandwich, chips, fruit/veg, bar, milk). Students may purchase (or use PIN ID) to obtain a bag lunch to take with them as they leave the building.
