Eastview will provide after school credit recovery classes for students to earn credit in the following courses:

- ✍ American Citizenship & Gov't A
- ✍ English
- ✍ Intermediate Algebra A
- ✍ United States History A
- ✍ Geometry A
- ✍ World History A
- ✍ Algebra 2A

**NOTE: Essential Math and Math Concepts courses are not offered for credit recovery.**

**Class Information**

The classes will be for make-up credit only; course availability is dependent on class enrollment. There is no cost for these classes. This program is only open to current Eastview High School students. Students will earn credit equivalent to a one-quarter course (.75 credits).

Classes are scheduled for Tuesday through Thursday beginning at 2:40 p.m. and ending at 4:00 p.m. **Students will receive a schedule the first day of class that outlines the mandatory class sessions, as well as self-directed class sessions. The course is taught using a combination of classroom and on-line instruction. Self-directed class sessions indicate when the work is achieved on-line, which the student can perform with supervision at school or outside of school. On-line assignments must be completed on the self-directed day assigned or an absence will be recorded for that day. Failure to complete on-line instructional assignments may result in dismissal from the course.**

**Extended Day Basic Rules**

- 1. A student who exceeds three (3) absences will not receive credit for the extended day class. Three (3) tardies equals one absence. Failure to attend class during the first three days will result in dismissal from the course.**
2. All regular school rules are in affect during the extended day class.
3. Grading will be pass or no-credit. (Letter grades will not be given)
4. Students are responsible for providing their own transportation.
5. After a student begins the course, they will have five days in which to drop the course. After that time, a student will receive a No Credit (NC) on their transcript.

**Students may register for the extended day program by picking up an application in the counseling office, filling it out and returning it to the counseling office before Tuesday, November 28, 2017**

**Registration is accepted on a first come first-served basis.**
