

#22 Ethan Thomforde, 6-0, Sr.



Ethan Thomforde is beginning his fourth and final season in a Lightning basketball uniform. Ethan is the last player left from the 2005 roster that made it to the State Championship. As a result, he has the opportunity to become the only four-year letter winner to wear an Eastview jersey. He is coming off a strong junior season in which he played in all 28 games, starting 25 of them. He averaged 9.8 ppg last season while earning all-conference honors and the coveted Lightning Defensive Award at the year end banquet. Ethan is regarded as one of the best defenders in the state as he can guard point guards, scoring guards, and even post players. His rare combination of speed, strength, and explosiveness for his size make him an ideal defender. Add these physical strengths to his intangibles of knowledge and experience and you can see how lucky the

Lightning Basketball program is to have such a special player. Ethan is also highly regarded as one of our hardest workers in the offseason. His commitments to weightroom, conditioning, and playing have earned him the honor of captain for his senior season. Over his career Ethan has compiled a record of 60-27.
