Current Events Presentation

Purpose:

You and a partner will be required to research a topic from a variety of different science publications. You will do a short power point presentation of your article and we as a class will have a discussion on the importance of the findings. The articles will need to be of a certain length that can only be determined by the teacher.

Presentations:

You will need the following things for your article:

- 1. Some sort of visual/graphic on every slide.
- 2. A minimum of 10 slides.
- 3. An outline for your short 2-3 minute presentation on notebook paper.
- 4. A citation of the magazine, newspaper article or web site and writer of the article in the following format: Name (Last name, First name). Name of article. Date.
- 5. An Introduction slide with your name, teachers name, class period and the name of your article.
- 6. Each slide in your presentation should explain one point raised in the article.

Grading:

The following rubric will be used while grading the presentation:
