

Counselors and teachers will return to school on Monday, August 26. Below is a list of answers to commonly asked questions for counselors during the summer months. Please review the information below, as your question(s) will likely be answered by one of them. **If you don't find the answer to your question below, please email or call me beginning August 26.**

- **CRISIS LINE:** If you, or someone close to you, are experiencing significant mental health concerns and feel you could benefit from intervention, please call the Dakota County Crisis Line at 952-891-7171 for 24 hour consultation services. If there is an emergency, please call 911.
- **SUMMER SCHOOL:** If you failed a core academic course, you may make up the credit through RHS Summer School. Session 1 is June 10 – June 26. Session 2 is July 8 – 24. Please call the Summer School Office for more information or to register at 651 423-7514. Trimester 3 failed core courses can be made up in the July summer school session.
- **TRANSCRIPTS:** 2019 graduates completed the Final Transcript Request in the senior survey on May 3, indicating where to send final transcripts. **Final transcripts will be sent electronically, beginning June 26, to the destination(s) that you indicated, and no further action is needed.** If you need other assistance with transcripts or paperwork, please contact the Registrar at 651-423-7518.

- **CLASS CHANGES:** If you would like to request a class change for the 2019-2020 school year, you may submit a request **Monday, August 5 - Friday, August 16.** Students may pick up a class change form in the Main Office or online beginning August 5 at <http://www.district196.org/rhs/forms/>. Return completed class change request forms to the Main Office. Please be sure to check Closed Class list before making requests as many courses are at capacity and cannot be added/changed.

- **COLLEGE APPLICATIONS:** College applications and transcript requests for the class of 2020 will be processed in the beginning of September. Please bring your requests in after the first week of school. **The college application process will be presented to Seniors during Senior Meetings with their counselor, scheduled for September 10.**
- **PSEO STUDENTS:** PSEO students should send a copy of Semester 1 PSEO enrollment to the counselor, and contact their counselor directly via email or by phone between Monday, August 20 and Thursday, August 23. **A copy of your first semester college schedule is required to confirm your enrollment and to make changes to your RHS schedule.**
