In order to participate in RHS Credit Recovery Summer School you must agree to and initial each statement below. You must also sign the agreement at the bottom of this page.

_____ The 2019 summer school program provides Rosemount High School students the opportunity to earn credits toward graduation. Courses offered and are for makeup credit only. Courses are available at no charge to students who attend Rosemount High School or live in the RHS attendance area. Students may earn up to four credits during summer school. Summer school will be divided into two sessions.

_____ Summer Session I will meet all weekdays June 10 – June 26. Summer Session II will meet all weekdays July 8 - July 24. Period 1 will meet from 7:30 - 10:15 a.m. Period 2 will meet from 10:20 a.m. - 1:05 p.m.

_____ All students attending will be responsible for providing their own transportation to and from Rosemount High School Summer School.

_____ Attendance is mandatory for all classes. Students are expected to be on-time for class every day. **Any missed time for any reason must be made up.** DO NOT schedule appointments, vacations, etc. during summer school dates/times.

_____ Students must have approval of a school counselor, administrator or case manager to enroll in summer school.

_____ Classes may be cancelled due to a lack of enrollment or staff availability.

_____ The campus is closed between classes. Students are NOT allowed to leave the building.

_____ All regular school rules are in effect during summer school. The police will be contacted to criminally charge any student whose behavior is also a violation of law; this includes vaping.

_____ Parking – students may park in the parent loop (but NOT visitor’s or reserved). Students may also park in the bus loop, staff lot, south lot or east lot.

_____ Bikes – Bikes must be placed in the bike racks and locked.

_____ Cell phones/head phones/ear buds and other similar items: Most teachers will collect cell phones at the beginning of class. Students who refuse to comply will NOT be allowed to attend summer school.

_____ Food/drinks: Generally, students are allowed to eat and drink during class unless doing so is disruptive. Students are responsible for any wrappers, lunch bags, and so forth. Sunflower seeds are strictly prohibited.
