Book with more than one author

Citation Elements:

Authors' Last Names, First Initials and Middle Initials (if provided). (Date of Publication). *Title of publication*.
Place of publication: Publisher.

Calfee, R. C., & Valencia, R. R. (1991). *APA guide to preparing manuscripts for journal publication*. Washington, DC: American Psychological Association.

Book or article with No Author named

Citation Elements:

Title of article. (Date of publication). *Publication title*. Page #.

Title of book. (Date of publication). Place of publication: Publisher.

Cigarette sales fall 30% as California tax rises. (1999, September 14). *New York Times*, A17.

The digital decade - The 90's: our American century. (2000). Alexandria, VA: Time-Life Books.

Book that is edited

Citation Elements:

Author's Last Name, First initial. (Eds.). (Date of publication). *Title of book*. Place of Publication: Publisher.

APA:

Sheehy, N., Chapman, A. J. and Conroy W. (Eds.). (1997). *Biographical dictionary of psychology*. London: Routledge.

Chapter of Book

Citation Elements:

Author of chapter. (Date). Title of chapter. In Editors of book. (Eds.), *Title of book*. (Page #'s of chapter). Place of Publication: Publisher.

Online Book (eBook Collection)

Citation Elements:

Author's Last Name, First Initial. (Date). *Title of book*. Place of publication: Publisher. Date of retrieval, name of database.

Article from a Reference Book with an Author

Citation Elements:

Author's last name, First Initial. (Date). Title of article. *Title of book*. (Vol. #, p. #). Place of publication: Publisher.

APA:

Kte'pi, B. (2008). China. *Encyclopedia of stem cell research*. (Vol. 1, pp. 98-100). Thousand Oaks, CA: Sage Publications Inc.

Article from a Reference Book without an Author

Citation Elements:

Title of Article. (Date). *Title of Reference Book*. (Vol. #, p. #). Place of Publication: Publisher.

APA:

Tree Shrews. (1996). *Gale encyclopedia of science*. (Vol. 6, pp. 3720-3722). New York: Gale Research.

Newspaper Article

Citation Elements:

Author's name. (Year Month Day). Title of Article. *Title of Newspaper*, page number(s).

APA:

Greeley, A. (1997, May 17). Today's morality play: The sitcom. *New York Times*, p. 1+.

Newspaper Article w/o Author

Citation Elements:

Title of Article. (Year Month Day). *Title of Newspaper*, page number(s).

APA:

Study says U.S. students' reading skills top many developed nations. (2003, August 25). *Star Tribune*, p.1A.

Magazine Article

Citation Elements:

Author's last name, first initial. (Date of article). Title of article. *Title of magazine*, Page #'s.

APA:

Poniewozik, J. (2000, November 20). TV makes a too-close call. *Time*, 70-71.

Motion Picture, Video or DVD

Citation Elements:

Producer, P. P. (Producer), & Director, D.D. (Director). (Date of publication). *Title of motion picture* [Medium of recording]. Country of origin: Studio or distributor.

APA:

Isaacs, Sir J., & Mitchell, P. (Producers). (1998). *Cold War*. [VHS]. CNN Perspectives. U.S.: Turner Original Productions.

Web Page

Citation Elements:

Authors of document. (Date posted). *Title of document*. Retrieved Date, from Name of Website: URL

Felluga, D. (1999, December 17). *Undergraduate guide to literary theory*. Retrieved from Purdue University: <http://omni.cc.purdue.edu%7Efelluga/theory2.html>

Article on a Web Site

Citation Elements:

Author, A. A., & Author, B. B. (Date of publication). Title of article. *Title of journal, volume number* (issue number if available). Retrieved from <http://Web address>.

APA:

Poland, D. (1998, October 26). The hot button. *Roughcut*. Retrieved from <http://www.roughcut.com>

Personal Communications -- Personal, Telephone, E-mail

(NOTE: Cite personal communications **in text only**, do not include in bibliography)

Citation Elements:

Interviewee's First Initial. Last Name (Type of interview Month Date, Year)

APA:

M. Hatch (telephone interview, August 22, 2005)
J. K. Rowling (e-mail interview, May 15-20 2005)

Twitter & Facebook

Citation Elements:

Name of person. (year, date). whole post in the title position. If lengthy truncate. [description of form]. Retrieved from URL of the post.

APA:

APA Citation Examples from Library Databases

General citation elements for library subscription databases. (if your citation does not include one of the elements, skip to the next element.)

Citation Elements:

Author. (Date of publication). Title of article. *Title of magazine/journal*. Volume # (if given). Page #'s. Supplier of Database. Database name. DOI # (Digital Object Identifier) of the article (if available).

* Always list the DOI # if there is one. DOI is preferable to a URL.
