Ceremony Location:

Outdoor (weather permitting) - Rosemount High School Stadium (unlimited seating)

Indoor (alternative weather location) – RHS Main Gymnasium (3 tickets per family) & RHS PAC (1 ticket per family)

In the event of an indoor ceremony, families have several options:

- The ceremony will be simulcast in the Performing Arts Center with air conditioning and comfortable seating available. One ticket is required for seating in the PAC
- The ceremony will be simulcast in RHS lecture rooms. No tickets are required for seating in the lecture rooms.
- The ceremony will be available live Saturday, June 3 at 7pm on District 196 Cable TV.

Graduation Clothing Recommendations/Considerations:

RHS takes pride on having a quality and sophisticated ceremony. We ask our graduates to celebrate this formal ceremony with the following recommendations:

Graduation Caps should be worn so they are parallel with the floor. The tassel should be over the left side. It is recommended that students wear long pants, dresses, dress shoes or dress sandals under the gown. Please **no** shorts, jeans, tennis shoes or flip flop shoes. If the ceremony is held outside, graduates should consider wearing a wider heeled shoe. Students should not wear corsages or other adornments on the gown. No messages allowed on the caps. No chewing gum. Storage is not available for purses, bags etc.

In addition, please do not bring items that would distract from the ceremony. Everyone has worked hard to get to this celebration and should have an equal opportunity to be recognized and celebrated.
